



MailSite Collaborator Use Case: Project Extranet

Greg and Helen both work for a small software business. They both like to run the latest software and so use Outlook 2007 running on Windows Vista to manage their mail, contacts and calendars.

Greg and Helen just started working on a new project where they interact with consultants from outside their company. They need to share their work calendars both with other employees in their company and with the consultants. The consultants each have their favorite calendaring programs including Windows Vista Calendar, Outlook 2007, Mac iCal and Google Calendar.

Greg and Helen's calendars are automatically synchronized between Outlook and their company's MailSite Collaborator server. By simply sending a link, they can share their schedules both with colleagues and the consultants. Even public services such as Google Calendar can be used to access Greg and Helen's shared information using the popular iCal format.
