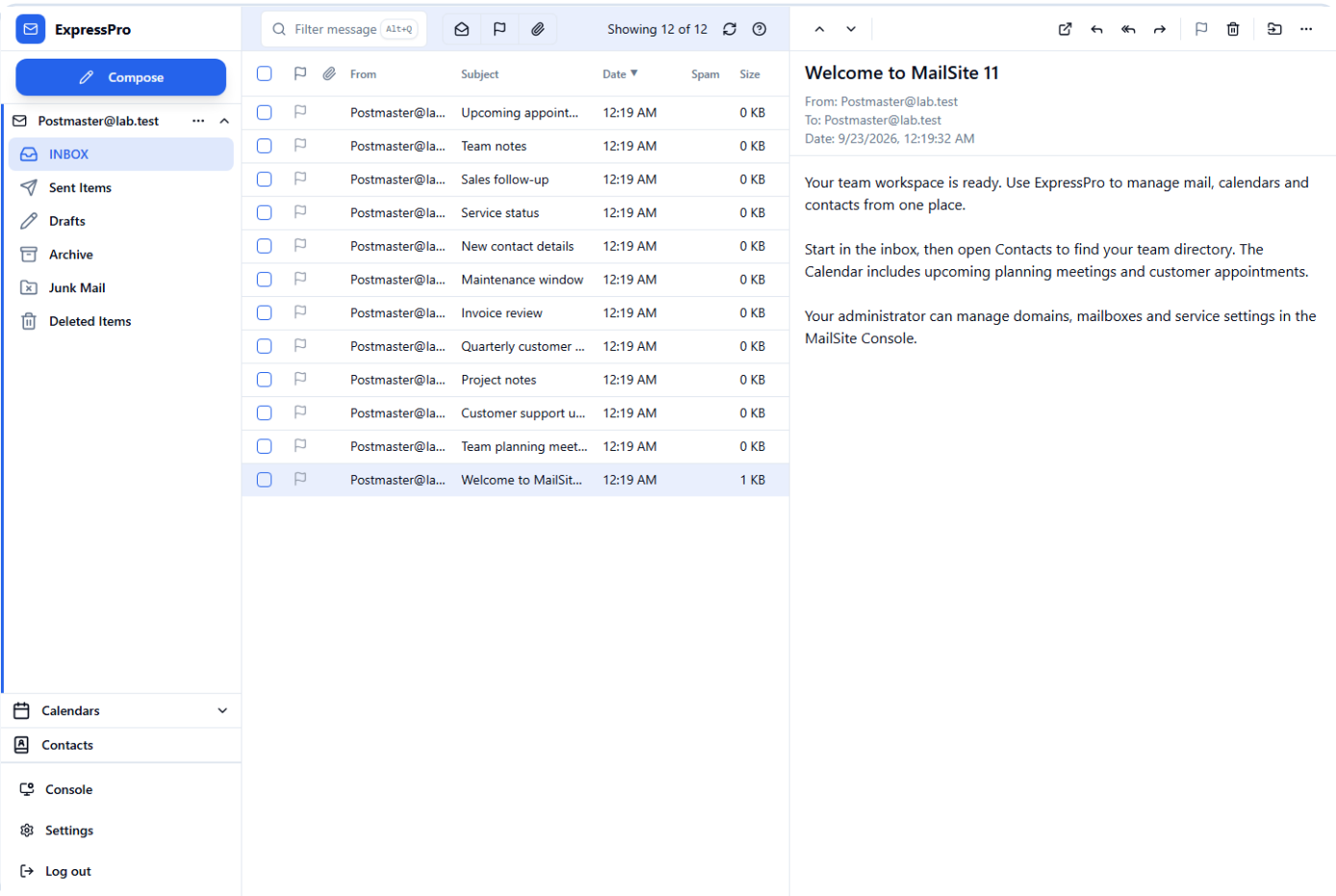


Email without the overhead

MailSite brings webmail, calendars, contacts, client synchronization and server administration together on infrastructure you control. Its own HTTP service serves webmail and synchronization without a separate IIS installation.

Mail and collaboration

A redesigned ExpressPro provides mail, contacts, calendars, search and account settings in a single workspace.

Administration

The Console manages domains, mailboxes, mailing lists, certificates, services and logs. Delegate access at the appropriate scope.

Security and filtering

Configure TLS and domain certificates, native ClamAV scanning, Bayesian spam filtering and Sieve mail rules.

Hosting and growth

Operate multiple domains and plan clustered deployments with shared storage, load balancing and backup.

Plan a reliable rollout

Test the client versions and workflows your organization uses, including meetings, sharing, contacts and offline access. Configure a trusted certificate and review the current release notes and upgrade guidance before moving production users. Back up both mailbox files and database-only state before upgrades that cross a reset boundary.
